TICKETING TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

All tables of 10 include:

- Entry to the PMA Charity Ball & Auction
- 3 Course meal
- Access to the open bar in the ballroom serving a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages
- Live entertainment throughout the night
- The opportunity to contribute greatly to a cause that touches us all – the support and development of our Pacific healthworkforce.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. No food or beverages may be taken into the event
2. Table location will be determined by the Organisers
3. All table purchases are non-refundable, other than in the instance of full cancellation of the event
4. In the event of a natural disaster, or a situation outside of the control of the PMA, the event may be cancelled. In the event of a full cancellation, table byers are welcome to apply for a refund (either full or partial) by emailing melissa@pacifichealth.org.nz . Alternatively, as the event is for such a worthy cause, this situation we would also invite ticket holders to generously forgo their refund, in which case their ticket cost would be donated directly to the Pasifika Medical Association Education Fund and a donation receipt would be issued.
5. Table purchases may be transferred into a different name prior to the event, however, all money exchanges for the table must happen directly by table seller/buyer. Any change in table ownership must be notified by email to melissa@pacifichealth.org.nz . The organisers will make every attempted to change the name of the seating plan if the change is made prior to printing the seating plan (7 days prior to the event).
6. Artist line-up and billed attractions may be subject to change.
7. Right of Admission reserved – in order to facilitate the security, safety and comfort of all guests, the organiser reserves the right to refuse admission without refund of ticket price.
8. Admission of Ticket Holders own risk. The Organiser will not be held liable for any loss, injuries or damages sustained at the event including damage, theft or losses to property and motor vehicles, if the cause is due to negligence of the ticket holder or the unforeseeable actions of other patrons.
9. A condition of entry to the ball is ticket holders consenting to being filmed and/or photographed for use in television, video, social media or printed promotional material.
10. The ticket holder consents to, all will permit, the search and inspection of his or her person, clothing, bags or other possessions by any official, employee of the proprietor of the venue.
11. The ticket holder may be required to provide proof of age when served alcohol. This must take the form of one of the following types of identification; a New Zealand Drivers License, New Zealand or Foreign Passport.
12. The Ticket Holder will be required to leave the venue if he or she; engages in conduct which unreasonably interferes with the enjoyment of the event by the patrons; hampers or impedes the conduct of the event; breaches any by-laws or orders applicable to the venue.
