Preference will be given to nurses undertaking Master's Programmes related to Nursing and or Health related studies. Applications will be considered for students who already receive other scholarship grants not exceeding \$5,000.00 per annum
Quantity and Amount of Awards	Two awards to the value of \$5000 each. Total value \$10,000
Eligibility Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be of an indigenous Pacific ethnic group. • Be a New Zealand resident - Citizen or Permanent Resident. • Be enrolled in the current year in a Post graduate Nursing or Health related programme of study in New Zealand. • Be engaged and connected with their Pacific nursing community and/or community. • Demonstrate experience in community leadership or aspirations to become a leader in their community. • Provide evidence of good standing in the community (2 x reference letters from a non-relative or family acquaintance).
Conditions of Acceptance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be available and willing to participate in PMA events and activities. • Agree to attend at least one PMA event per year over the course of their studies. • Agree to have their photo taken for scholarship promotional and communications purposes, and PMA reports. • Be engaged in the work of the PMA group. • Agree to participate in and receive mentorship, cultural and pastoral supervision from a mentor appointed by PMA. • Provide progress updates and report at the end of every academic year. • Advise PMA of any changes in study situation and contact details during their period of study.
